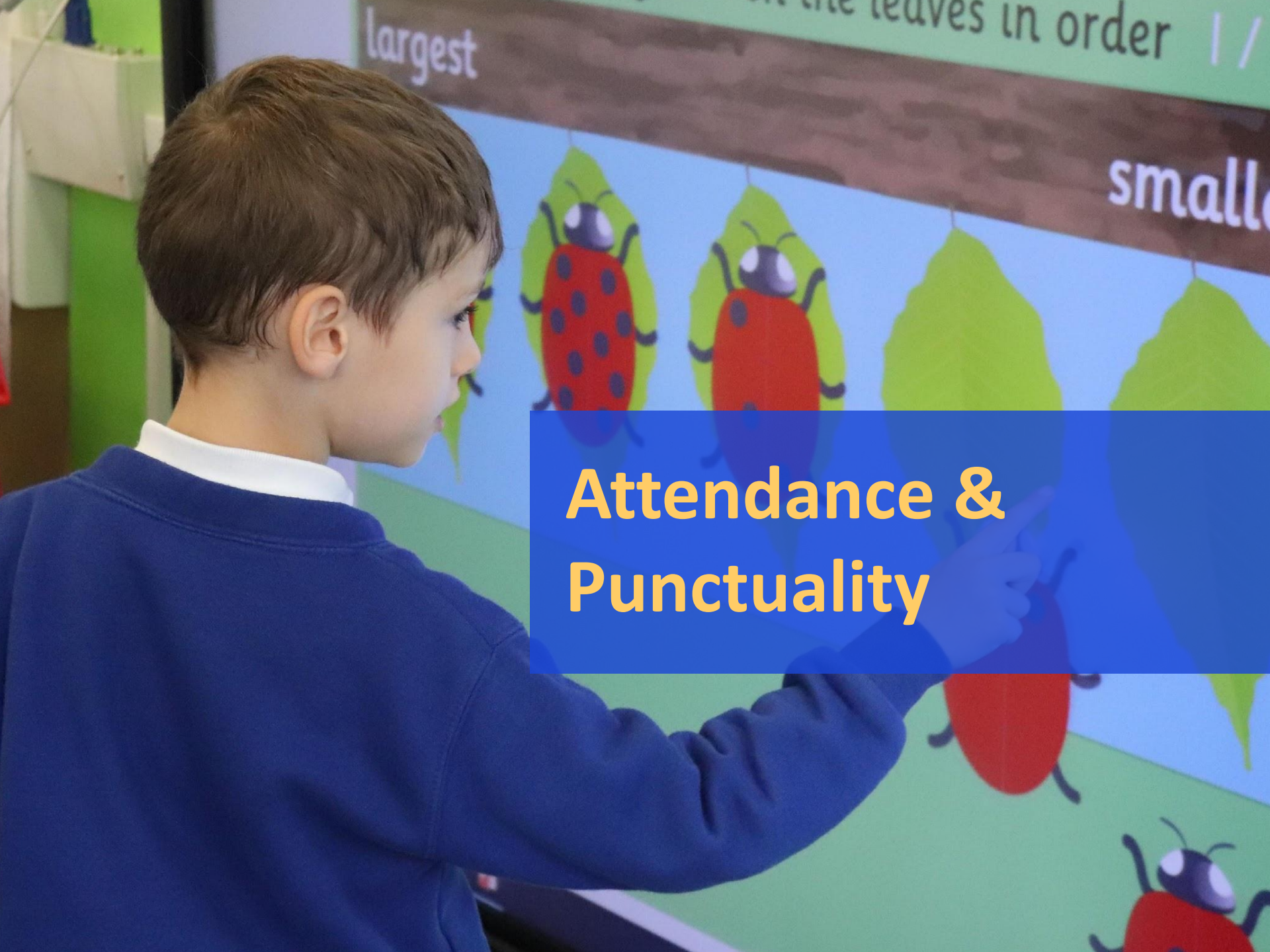

Lost learning:

- half a day a week

Attendance concern

- 1 day a week
- 1 half term a year

Parentmail and Admissions+

- You will begin receiving some communications from the school office within the next few days.
- Please download the Parentmail App once you have registered your Parentmail account, and ensure that you are receiving emails from the school office.
- Data Collection Form via Admissions+ to be completed no later than **14th July** (more information via email from admissions@stoughton.surrey.sch.uk will be sent within the next few days - check junk folder).
- You will be emailed a digital copy of the welcome letter which has links to important documents such as the dietary requirements form and pupil premium form.
- Allergy, medication, asthma care plans are available from the school office in person or request via email to infants@stoughton.surrey.sch.uk.



Studybugs

- › You'll be reminded to register for Studybugs in September, but please register before your child's first day if possible.
- › This is a free app (self registration) that you can log your child's absences automatically to the school

Transition Sessions

- › Face to face sessions in July
- › Settling in sessions in September
- › 1-1 Zoom meetings in September - book via ParentMail
- › Video links will be sent showing the classroom and teachers reading a story



Please wait at the Stoughton Road entrance. A member of the reception team will come and let you in. There's no need to ring the buzzer on the gate.

Over the summer holidays, please encourage your child to develop these skills by:



- › Share the story time clip with your child.
- › Practice saying and waving goodbye.
- › Trying new things and having a go... “It’s not I can’t, It’s I can”
- › Concentrating and completing 1 activity at a time, even if they find it a little tricky
- › Develop self care skills by being able to dress and undress themselves...
- › **Please develop children’s independence when using the toilet.**
- › Encourage children to use a knife and fork in preparation for September
